



## Saturday, September 5, Wedding in La Orotava

We are going to get married on September 5, 2009 at 6 p.m. in the city hall of La Orotava on the island of Tenerife. The subsequent celebration will take place at 7 p.m. in the gardens of the Marquesado de la Quinta Roja (also known as Jardines Victoria, **point D** in the map on the second page), which are located within two minutes walking distance from the city hall.

**Meeting point:** 5:30 p.m. in front of the city hall at **point A** (the points of interest are marked in the map on the second page). We recommend you to come a bit earlier and have a stroll through the historic town, which is worth a visit. After the ceremony, please wait for us at the meeting point in front of the city hall in order to take some pictures of all of us together.

### By bus:


**From Santa Cruz:** Take bus 108 in direction Icod de los Vinos at the bus station in Santa Cruz at 4:15 p.m., which arrives in La Orotava (**point B**) around 5 p.m.

**From Puerto de la Cruz:** Bus 350 leaves the bus station at 5 p.m. (there are busses every 30 minutes) and arrives around 5:15 p.m. at the bus station of La Orotava (**point B**).

**Return:** In order to go to Puerto de la Cruz, it will be best to share a taxi with other guests. For other destinations please organise a shared ride or other ways to get back to where you are staying.

## By car:

Coming from Santa Cruz, head west on highway TF-5. Take exit 33 and go up the hill in direction of La Orotava. First, follow the main road in direction El Teide for around 1km. When this street makes a sharp left turn, you have to go right in direction of the "Casco Histórico" and then immediately turn left on the next road. This street passes by the city hall (**point A**) after around 400m. Having passed the city hall, you turn right at the next street (passengers, who don't want to walk up from the parking, can get out here) in order to find a parking spot. By arriving at **point C** you should have found one.
